2010 Community Fund Grant Application

Submission Deadline: September 10, 2010

In 2010, the Harvest Co-op Board of Directors will award **one to three** Community Fund grants totaling \$6,500 to community organizations.

To be eligible, an organization must: 1) Be a registered 501 (c) 3, or other non-profit; 2) Conduct activities that support Cambridge, Jamaica Plain, or neighboring communities inside Rt. 128; and 3) Operate in a manner consistent with the Harvest mission. (<http://www.harvest.coop/mission.html>)

Successful applicants are likely to also undertake or propose activities that: 1) Provide opportunities for Harvest member engagement; 2) Are food related, broadly defined; and 3) Are in the spirit of the Seven Principles of Cooperation. (<http://www.harvest.coop/learn/index.html>)

The Harvest Co-op Membership and Social Concerns Committee will review the applications and select up to 10 organizations to be considered, all of which will receive publicity in October. Awardees will be notified and funds dispersed after the Board of Directors makes its final decision at its meeting in December 2010.
